## Week 1: Qualifying Round: Friday May 14, 2010 @ 7:00pm

Qualifying Round Limited to 240 Bowlers, 120 Men & 120 Women (5 Per Lane x 48 Lanes)

## Week 2: Championship Round: Friday May 21, 2010 @ 7:00pm

Championship Round Limited to 192 Bowlers, 96 Men & 96 Women (4 Per Lane x 48 Lanes)

Limited Space, Sign up ASAP, Don't be shut out!! This is an invitation ONLY tournament for Stardust Bowl III League Bowlers.

### What can you win?\$\$?

- 1st Place Male will win a Guaranteed \$600 or more depending on entries and FREE League Lineage for Bowling the next Season in any one league at Stardust Bowl III (about a \$360 value). You also get the 1<sup>st</sup> Place Crystal Bowling Pin Trophy.
- 1st Place Female will win a Guaranteed \$600 or more depending on entries and FREE League Lineage for Bowling the next Season in any one league at Stardust Bowl III (about a \$360 value). You also get the 1<sup>st</sup> Place Crystal Bowling Pin Trophy.
- Cash Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries & depending on the place you finish. Last year 1 in 4 cashed
- The Top 5 Bowlers from Week 1, Men and Women, will Win a Cash Bonus
- More Money will be added to the Prize Fund from the House Side Pots from each day of league throughout the season.
- Optional Side Pots & Brackets will be available in both Week #1 & Week #2. Last year there was over 80 brackets each week

### Rules on how to get an invitation

- You must bowl in a Fall League at Stardust Bowl III. More leagues you bowl, the more chances you have to get an invitation.
- The Highest Handicap Series (Male & Female) in your league will be invited to bowl the Qualifying Round. Entry Fee \$20
- The Bowler of the Week (Male & Female) with the Highest Scratch Series out of all the leagues will earn a Bye for Week #1 the Qualifying Round & Advance straight to Week #2 in the Championship Round. They also earn a 1/2 Price Entry of \$10.
- All Honor Score Games of 291-300 & ALL 800+ Series will get an invite. Entry Fee \$15
- Special League Leader Invitations will also be passed out for the Top Bowlers on your standing sheet for High Scratch & Handicap Game, High Scratch & Handicap Series, and High Averages in each league at the end of the bowling season. Entry Fee \$25. This is a Stand by List in case the Bowlers of the Week do not fill the Qualifying Round. You may not get a spot in the tournament. Please sign up early because it is still a first come first serve basis. This will be the last of the invitations to go out.
- Bowlers must have 21 games or more in a single league. If you do not have 21 games in a single league but bowled in multiple Stardust III Leagues, we will combine all leagues bowled and come with a composite average as long as they all add up to 21 games or more. If you end up not having bowled 21 games in the combined leagues, you are not eligible to bowl this tournament. I bet you'll get your games in next season!

### Tournament Format

- Week #1: Qualifying Round May 7, Limited to the first 240 Bowlers (120 Men & 120 Women) pre-pay sign ups. Bowl 3 Games, Scratch Score plus Handicap. Handicap is 80% of 230. The number of bowlers that advance will be determined by the number of sign ups. Scores do NOT carry over to Week #2. Pre-Pay ahead of time, limited space! Don't be shut out
- Week #2: Championship Round May 14, Limited to 192 Bowlers (96 Men & 96 Women). This will consist of the bowlers that advance from Week #1 and the Bowlers who were the Bowler of the Week that earned a Bye in Week #1. They will Bowl 3 games. After 3 games the Top 16 Men & Top 16 Women will Roll Off in a 1 on 1 single elimination handicap bracket with Places 1-4 getting a bye in the first round of match play. Winners advance, Losers are done. This will crown the Stardust Bowl III Bowler of the Year.
