3rd Annual 40 Frame 9 Pin No Tap Game Tournament at Stardust Bowl III (2021)

- 1. Bowl the 40 Frame 9 Pin No Tap on one pair of lanes. You cannot bowl on a single lane. Lanes must alternate.
- 2. The 40 Frame 9 Pin No Tap is bowled on existing lane conditions at the time that you bowl. At least 24 lanes are oiled on weekdays around 5pm and at various times on the weekend. Please call ahead for lane availability.
- 3. Open to male and female bowlers. Youth bowlers will be allowed to bowl, but ALL PRIZE MONEY WILL BE CONVERTED INTO SCHOLARSHIP MONEY THROUGH THE USBC S.M.A.R.T. PROGRAM. If a youth bowler fails to notify the tournament staff of their youth status, they will be disqualified, forfeit all prize money, and be reported to the USBC. A Youth Waiver form must be signed by the bowler and parent/guardian (if under 18) PRIOR to bowling,
- 4. Please bring your USBC Card # for quick average verification.
- 5. Handicap is based on 90% of 230 using highest book average from the last two seasons (2019-20, 2020-21) with 42 games or more. Averages are posted on bowl.com. If no average for the past 2 seasons, you must go back and take the highest average from the 3 previous seasons that is posted on bowl.com with 42 games or more. If no average exists on bowl.com, you will bowl scratch. Sport Leagues and college averages will be re-rated using the Sport Bowling Conversion Chart. 2020-2021 averages are unofficial until verified on bowl.com. Since 2020-2021 averages are usually posted mid-summer, averages can be re-rated if the incorrect average was written on the tournament form.
- 6. Entry fee: \$25 per person + Optional 10th Frame "300" Shares (\$5 each). You may re-enter as many times as you want. You can cash only once in the main Handicap prize fund, but you can cash multiple times in the 10th frame 300 Shares pot.
- 7. Groups of 10 or more bowlers are asked to make a reservation to insure lanes ready for you.
- 8. Entry Fee Breakdown per person. Prize Fund: \$16 + Lineage: \$8 + Expenses: \$1 = Entry: \$25.
- 9. Prize fund will vary depending on the final number of paid entries.
- 10. Optional 10th Frame "300" Shares Pot. \$5.00 entry each time you bowl. If you throw the last 3 strikes in the 10th Frame of all 4 games, you earn a share of the 10th Frame "300" side pot. Cash as many times as you win. If there is no winner of the side pot, the money will be added to the main prize fund.
- 11. This is not a sanctioned tournament, however all 10-pin rules apply except bowling opposite handed. If you have a left and right handed average, you must use the higher of the two unless there is a visible injury or you have a doctor's note that prevents you from using that hand.
- 12. Tournament payout will be done about 1 week after end of the tournament. If you cash, you can pick up your prize money during business hours. Please bring photo I.D. Checks will be mailed by request only.
- 13. Tournament results will be posted on <u>www.bowlstardust.com</u>.
- 14. All decisions are made final by the Tournament Director. The Director has the right to re-rate bowler's averages or refuse entries if necessary.
